Planned in 1870 by architect Gösta Gerdsjö, the building was not constructed until the 1930s. It has housed a police office and a courtroom.

How many pillars does the music pavilion have?

This building played a role in developing Borgholm as a seaside resort. In the evenings, orchestras performed here. The surrounding park was renovated in the early 2000s.

The house was built in 1850. It once housed Ljungström's café and bakery. The bread was baked in the neighboring building and sold in the space where the hairdresser is located today.

Hulda Ljungström ran the business here with help from her brother, a pastry chef. In 1946, Ebba and Oscar Svenson bought it from Signe Andersson, giving the business its name.

12



This building once housed Apotek Hjorten. The pharmacist's residence was located above the pharmacy. Built in 1903, old medicine cabinets have also been found in the nearby outbuilding.
